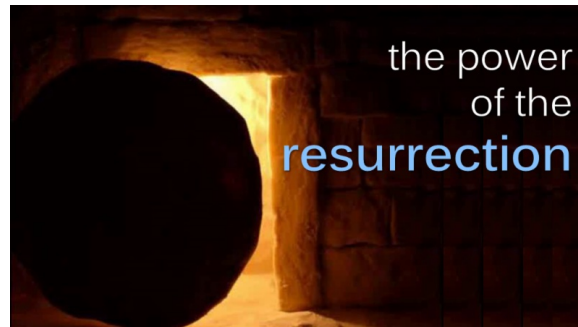

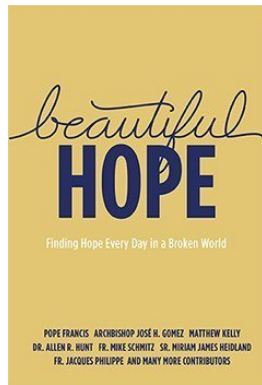

Summer Moms Alpha Opportunity!

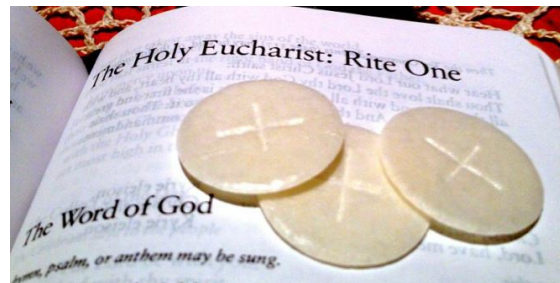

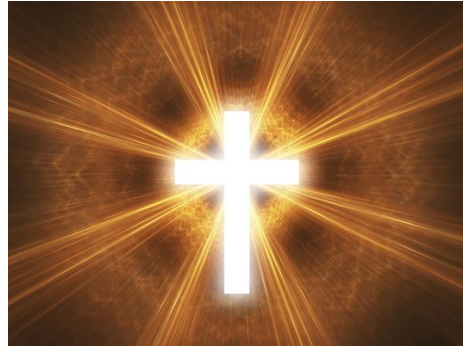
